

Dear Parent/Carer

RE: Cleeve Park Sports Day

The PE team have been working hard organising the first sports day Cleeve Park has seen for nearly 5 years and can confirm this will take place on **Wednesday 12th July (8:30-14:15)**. We are very excited at the inclusive and high performance mix we have been able to provide and we know that our students will have a wonderful day! Whilst we cannot allow for parents to watch sports day we hope that you will be able to see the great fun and excitement through our social media channels.

Students should arrive at the normal school time of 8:30, wearing full Cleeve Park PE kit. Students will be directed to their tutor rooms where they will be registered and final arrangements for the day will be provided. At 9:00am our first events will begin and at 14:15 our day will conclude. The school field will be split into four zones: track events, field events, team games and inflatables and all students will rotate through the zones during the course of the day. We will be spending the majority of the day out on the field therefore all students should be appropriately dressed for the weather (sun hat, sun cream, rain jacket) and have ample snacks and drinks. Please note there will not be a break time food offer on this day. Students will stop for lunch at 12:00 where the canteen will be open as usual.

School will finish at 2:15pm and the local bus companies have been informed. In the event of inclement weather and should the risk be too great then sports day may be cancelled.

The expectation is that students should arrive in their full Cleeve Park PE kit and be dressed as they would be for any PE lesson (eg. long hair tied up, no jewellery). The PE department has some available kit in the office so if your child is missing an item please send them along prior to the day and we will happily provide them with some. One of our sports day events will allow the students to take part in some fun inflatable games and activities. All risk assessments have been checked and the rules of each inflatable will be adhered to in order to minimise risk but if you do not want your child to use the inflatables please email me (ben.crouch@cleevepark-tkat.org).

Our main priority for sports day is that all students are able to take part but most importantly have fun. In order for this to be achieved, we expect students to behave in an appropriate manner which includes supporting other athletes and remaining respectful to staff. We are really excited to be having sports day this year and are looking forward to seeing our school community enjoying themselves!
