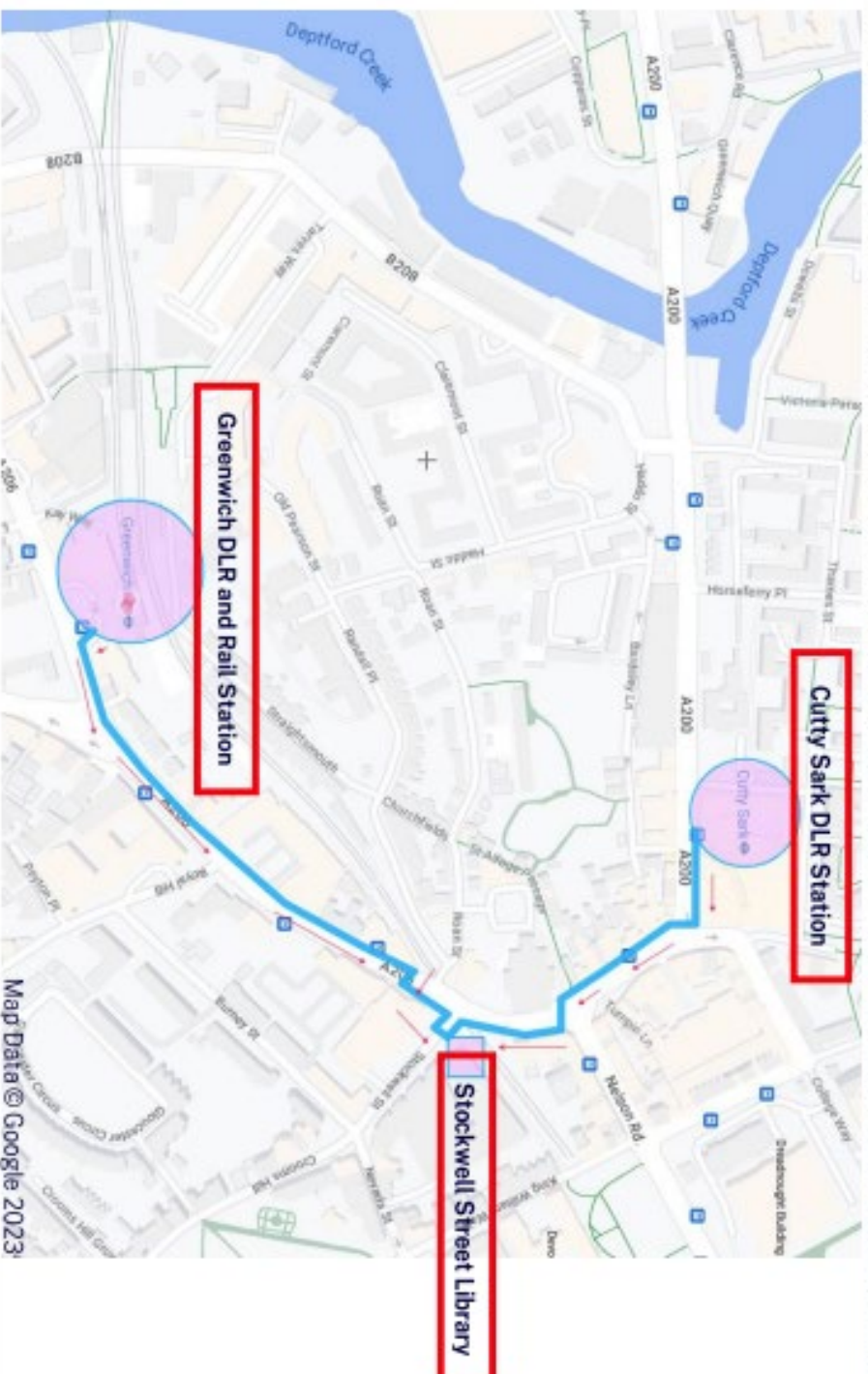





Do I choose Home or International?

- As our activities are based in and targeted at UK-based students, please select Home.

What if you can't find your school or college?

- Please select 'Other'

Why do you need my date of birth and postcode?

- So that we are able to evaluate the effectiveness of our activities against students from certain areas and age ranges, so that we can make sure our work is reaching as many students as we can.

What is my year of entry?

- Year of entry is the year that you would be able to join university, for example after finishing your Level 3 qualification (A Levels, T Levels, BTEC etc.). For example, if you are in Year 12 from 2022-23 and going into Year 13 from 2023-24, then your year of entry would be 2024. Alternatively, if you are in Year 13 from 2022-23, then your year of entry would be 2023.

What is the difference between undergraduate and postgraduate?

- An undergraduate degree is a Level 6 qualification completed at a University or other Higher Education Provider. A postgraduate degree is a Level 7 qualification as you have already graduated. Most students will select undergraduate as they will want to progress onto an undergraduate degree.
